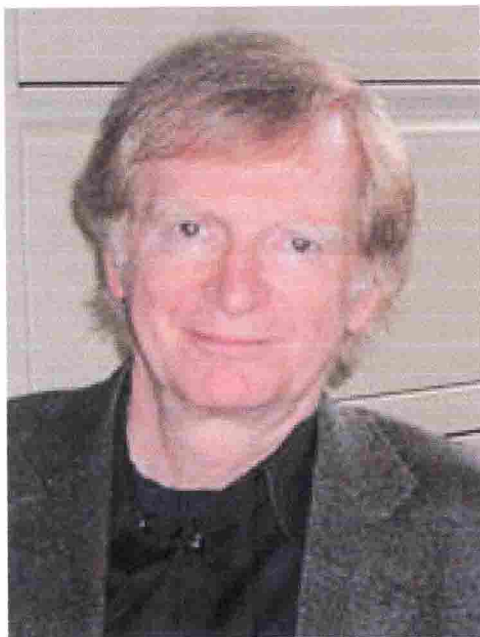

Thomas F. Babor

Is Professor and Health Net, Inc., Endowed Chair, Department of Community Medicine and Health Care, University of Connecticut, School of Medicine, Farmington, Connecticut. Dr. Babor's research interests include screening, diagnosis, early intervention, and treatment evaluation, as well as cultural factors related to alcohol and drug problems. He is also interested in studying predatory publishing and its impacts on scientific community. Dr. Babor is president of the International Confederation of Addiction Research Associations (ICARA) and past president of International Society of Addiction Journal Editors (ISAJE). Among other editorial board memberships he is Associate Editor-in-Chief and Regional Editor of the international journal *Addiction* and editor of the *Journal of Studies on Alcohol and Drugs*. For his contributions in research and public health he received several national and international awards. Dr. Babor published more than 200 articles which are cited more than 17 thousand times.

13,00 – 14,15 Predatory Publishers and Pseudo-journals: A Growing Threat to Health Science, Clinical Medicine and Professional Careers

The name predatory publisher has been applied by academic librarian Jeffrey Beall to describe an open-access, scholarly publishing business model in which publication fees are charged to authors without providing the editorial judgment, peer-review process, and publishing services associated with more established journals. In the biomedical and health science research many journal titles now operate according to this model. Predatory publishing should not be equated with open access. Prof. Babor will explain how to recognize predatory publishers, point on the cascade of effects resulting from the shabby publication process, including the damage done to the reputations of naive authors and figurehead editorial board members, and suggest actions to prevent further damage to the integrity of science.
